- Family €50

<u>HOW TO BORROW</u>: Books, DVDs & CDs may be taken out by residents from Monaco and the nearby regions in France and Italy. Those wishing to borrow books/recordings must become a member. Please complete the Reader Membership Form and provide the required documents:

- **Proof of identity & residency**: *carte d'identité*, *carte de séjour*, passport, student card, utility bill &*tc*.
- Membership fee per year: 25€ adult; 40€ Married couple You will have priority for attendance at our events and series of lectures. Note: 15€ for university level students valid for the duration of studies.
- Family membership fee per year 50€; <u>or</u> children can become members 8€ per child (8€ covers membership until 18 years old).
- Loan Specifications: Members may borrow up to 4 books & 2 DVDs/CDs for six weeks, renewable several times, unless the title has been requested by another reader. Renewal can be made by telephone or e-mail: info@pgil.mc
